

### A look back at 2015

- Consolidated Grant (CG) is the major grant for PPE group, pays for RA salaries, kit, travel, ...
- Old CG is £2.6M from Oct 2012 to Sept 2015/16
- New CG was submitted in early 2015, outcome at end of 2015
- New CG award is £3.0M from Oct 2015/16 to Sept 2019

- Expect lots of data to be analysed
- Will hopefully find some bumps and asymmetries



#### Current focus - take 2

- LHCb upgrade Edinburgh has set up a test centre for RICH photon detectors and will work on upgrade triggers
- Hyper-K project has started, plan is to develop neutrino long baseline activity
- Dark Matter LUX is taking data and LZ is under construction
- ATLAS upgrade prepare major bid for phase 2 construction of inner tracker


