#### The NuFFER committee

**Chair:** Annika Thiel

**Co-Chair:** Michail Athanasakis-Kaklamanakis

- 2 ECRs per NuPECC representative
- Researchers working on their PhD thesis or within 10 years of the completion of their PhD will be eligible to be elected as representatives
- Representatives must be based in Europe
- The membership term lasts for 3 years, with possible renewal only once
- The committee is led by a chair and co-chair for a term of 2 years, with possible re-election only once.
- The chair will be invited to the NuPECC meetings as an observer and will report the views of the NuFFER committee regularly
- The committee should meet at least twice a year
- Observers can be invited to meetings, for example to seek adequate diversity among the participants
